Illustrated Alphabet Wall

Great for ages 2-5

Staying at home for long periods of time can be taxing on everyone. Having a long term project set aside for your little ones can be a great distraction from being at home for extended periods of time. This alphabet wall is a fun art project and a great way to have your little ones involved in learning their ABCs!

Try sticking to only animals and spend some time with your kids researching and looking at new animals online!

They might have a new favourite animal after this!



Materials Needed:

- A large sturdy board. Cardboard or even a blank wall in need of decoration works!
- Paper
- Paint or markers or crayons
- Glue

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Steps:

- On each sheet, write one letter from the alphabet
- Research animals that start with the letter together and learn something new together!
- Have your little one decorate one sheet at a time, matching the animal to the letter
- Glue the sheets to your board or a wall for your little ones to see and to refer back to as they learn their ABCs!

Tips:

- You could stick the sheets to individual pieces of cardboard and challenge your little one to find a specific letter or organize them into order!
- For older kids, this activity could be done with another language! This could be a fun chance for everyone in the family to start on a new hobby
