Steps:

- Have your child draw on a design for the fish
- Have your child trace out their hand and then supervise them as they slowly cut out their traced hand from the paper
- Glue on the googly eyes, or if you don't have any at home, draw on some eyes with a marker
- Glue on any decorative pieces and then glue on a popsicle stick

Tips:

- Looking for what you could use as decorations for the fish? You could use bottle caps or leftovers from other crafts.
