
Toilet Paper Roll Jellyfish

Materials:

- Coffee Filters
- Googly Eyes
- Rubber bands/ Tape
- Crayons
- Markers
- Glue
- Colored Paper
- Scissors

Steps:

- 1. Set up materials for each participant; giving them each a toilet paper roll with the coffee filter, and any other materials needed.
- 2. First, decorate the coffee filter according to the design wanted.
- 3. Then, place the middle of the coffee filter on top of the toilet paper roll whilst placing a rubber band or tape around it in the center; bonding the two.
- 4. Last of all, have the children add the finishing touches to their jellyfish, like the googly eyes.
