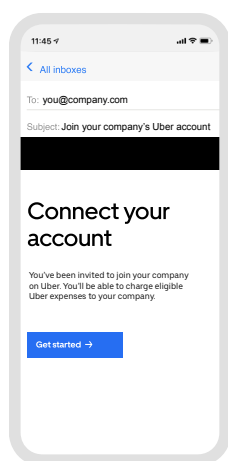


Once you're set up, seamlessly switch from personal to business meal orders by selecting your company profile in the Uber Eats app. Your work meals will be charged to your company.

Getting started: Already have a personal Uber account?

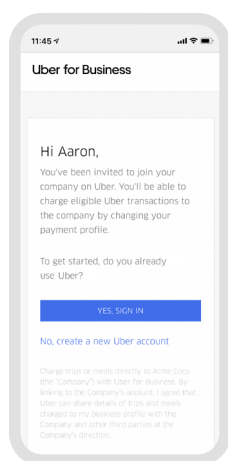
Check your work email for an invitation from Uber for Business.

Note: if you're asked to sign in to Uber, please use your original Uber credentials; they're the same for Uber Eats.



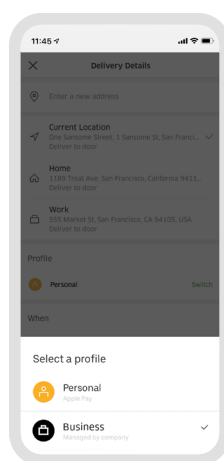

Select "Yes, sign in" if you're an existing Uber user.

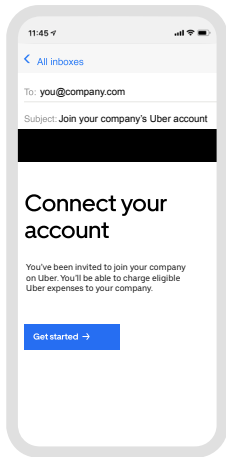


3.

Open the Uber Eats app and switch to your company profile when ordering meals for work.

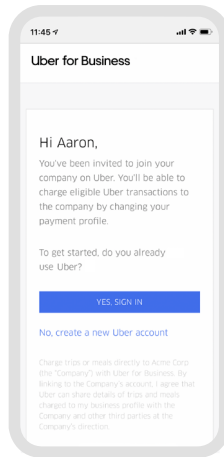
Getting started: New to Uber?

Check your work email for an invitation from Uber for Business.



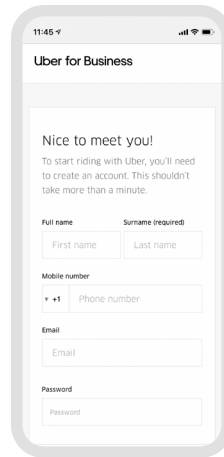

Tap "Get started" in your invite email.



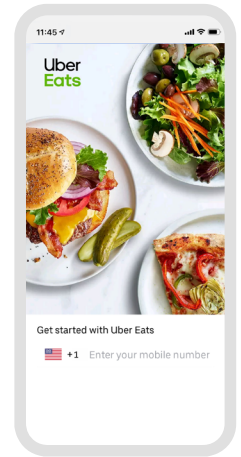

Complete the required fields to create a personal Uber account.

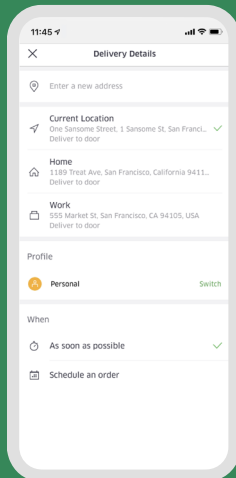

Download the Uber Eats app and log in.

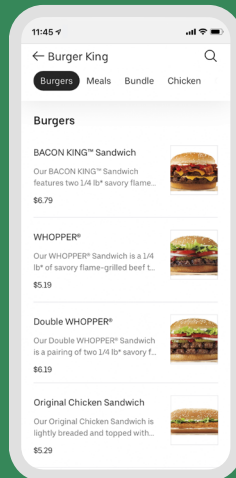
When you're ready to eat

Seamlessly switch between personal and business within the Uber Eats app.



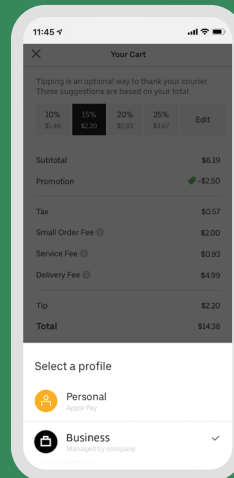

Tap the Address drop-down and enter a delivery address.



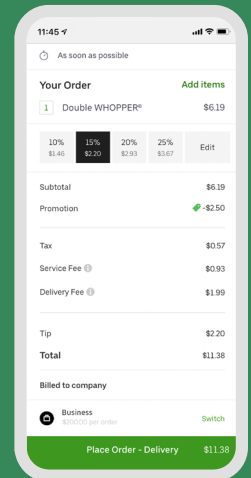
