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Activity : Photo Scavenger Hunt
Location : Outside School, Nearest waterway
Target Audience : Elementary Student (>4th grade)
Materials : Camera/Phone, Printer, Paper, Glue, Drawing stuff, Scissors.
Time Length : Max 2 Days
Safety Note :

Children should be in groups, be supervised and wear PFDs when near the water and teachers should help them when using the scissors.

Description :

The project is essentially a normal scavenger hunt, but we don't take the real object, we only take the photo of the object (nature-friendly). The teacher is going to give the student a list of objects (just the clue) and the students are going to find the objects in the list. The game location is the nearest beach or waterway. Once the student has found an object, he or she will plot its location on a simple map which shows some basic features of the area --sandbars, large logs, tidepools etc. At the end of the game, a small prize may be offered. While the prizes are being passed around the teacher should inform the students about the fact that less than 10% of the ocean has been explored as well as any information pertinent to the local area.

On the second day or the afternoon of the first if the morning went quickly, the students will print a few of their favourite photos and create posters about the ocean. They are going to decorate their photo poster. All of the posters are going to be posted in the school hallways so that all other students can also see it, and learn something.
